Ladies 2 Person Scramble

- Stroke Play - 30% handicap differential (using course handicap)
 - Low team plays as a scratch
 - Other team will receive 30% of the difference
 - Team 1
 - Golfer 1 Handicap 10
 - Golfer 2 Handicap 4
 - Combined Handicap $14 - 10 = 4 \times 30\% = 1.2$
 - Team 1 receives 1 stroke on hardest hole
 - Team 2
 - Golfer 3 Handicap 2
 - Golfer 4 Handicap 8
 - Combined Handicap 10 = SCRATCH
- All golfers **WILL** play from the **Yellow Tees**
- All matches **WILL** be **18 holes**, unless conceded before that point
- All golfers **MUST** possess a current and valid **GAO** handicap prior to the first match. Any golfer playing a match without a current and valid GAO will automatically forfeit that match.
 - GAO handicap can be purchased in the pro shop or online at <https://gao.ca/golfer-membership/>
- Team on the top bracket is responsible for booking the match, however, bottom team can also initiate contact
- Match **MUST** be completed by posted date
 - Incomplete matches will be provided one (1) tee time determined by the Ladies Golf Committee.
 - If either team can not participate in this match, the match will be determined by a two (2) out of three (3) coin flip performed by the Games Ladies Golf Committee.
- All grievances and/or rule challenges will be directed to and resolved by the Ladies Golf Committee.

Definition of Scramble Play

Scramble format involves 2-person teams where each player on the team hits a tee shot, and then the players decide which shot they like better. The two players then play from that spot. The person who's shot was not taken picks up their ball and moves it to within one club length of the selected spot. Once the spot is selected, both players then play a shot from that spot, and again pick which one they like better. This continues until the hole out.

ADDITIONAL RULES

- Players are allowed to place their ball within one club length of the selected spot (no closer to the hole)
- Players cannot change which cut of grass their ball is in (i.e. you cannot place your ball in the fairway if your marker is in the rough)
